The program followed a two-phase model:

- Phase 1: Intensive leadership and industry immersion in Dubai
- Phase 2: Paid education-integrated work placement in Germany

A key achievement of this cohort is that students secured placements and visas without holding a completed bachelor's degree, demonstrating the strength of profile-based, skill-oriented global pathways.
